Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children/Adolescents (WCC)




Who is eligible?

Children and adolescents 3-17 years of age who had an outpatient visit with a primary care practitioner or OB/GYN during the measurement year and had evidence of:

- Body mass index (BMI) percentile documentation.
- Counseling for nutrition.
- Counseling for physical activity.

Because BMI norms for youth vary with age and gender, this measure evaluates whether BMI percentile is assessed, rather than an absolute BMI value.

NOTE: Four individual codes are required to capture the WCC measure appropriately.
